WORD	DEFINITION
1. survey (noun)	a collection of answers from many people about questions on a topic (also called a questionnaire)
2. confined (verb)	kept in one place and unable to spread.
3. hatched (adjective)	newly born from an egg
4. barely (adverb)	hardly, only just, very slightly
5. visible (adjective)	able to be seen
6. inspect (verb)	check something carefully to make sure it doesn't have any problems
7. excrement (noun)	waste from a body (also known as feces and poop)
8. smears (noun)	marks left from rubbing something dirty
9. clumps (noun)	groups of things that are very close together physically
10. stigma (noun)	social disapproval of something (which is often unfair)
11. unhygienic (adjective)	unclean (dirty enough to cause illness)
12. transported (verb)	moved from one place to another
13. react (verb)	show negative physical effects from a poison or other substance
14. asymptomatic (adjective)	not showing any physical signs of having an illness or disease.
15. skewed (verb)	showing results in favour of one side more than another
16. mobility (noun)	ability to move
17. crevices (noun)	large cracks in something hard such as walls or wood
18. discarding (verb)	throwing something in the garbage
